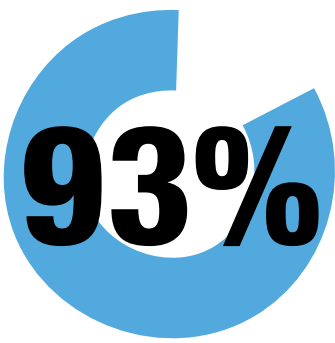

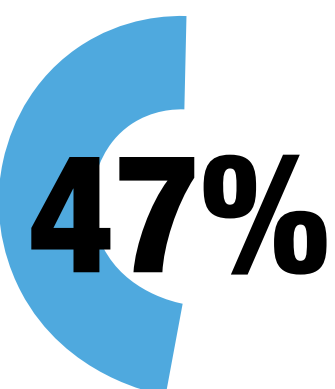
THE VALUE OF AN MBA
